

Leander Comprehensive Plan & Transportation Master Plan Update



The City of Leander is updating its **Comprehensive Plan and Transportation Master Plan** concurrently to plan for Leander's future.

These plans guide how the city grows, moves, and invests in infrastructure across the city limits and extraterritorial jurisdiction (ETJ). This integrated approach will help the City proactively manage growth, support economic vitality, and preserve the character and quality of life valued by the community.

What are the plans?

Comprehensive Plan

- Highlights how Leander has changed over the past and creates a vision for Leander's future
- Provides goals and strategies to implement the vision of the city
- Serves as the policy guide and framework for land use decisions for the next decade

Transportation Master Plan

- Serves as the policy guide to plan Leander's future transportation system as well as address immediate transportation needs in Leander
- Seeks to maximize the use of current transportation infrastructure to manage congestion and accommodate growth
- Considers roads, transit, and active transportation options such as walking & biking

How are the plans used?

1 Community

(Citizens, Business owners, Developers)

- Use the **Comprehensive Plan** to understand future plans for properties and impacts on neighborhoods
- Use the **Transportation Master Plan** to learn about future transportation initiatives and potential projects

4 City Council

- Use the **Comprehensive Plan** to make decisions regarding City policies, budgeting, and planning and zoning cases
- Use the **Transportation Master Plan** to guide and prioritize transportation projects recommended by the plan

2 City Staff

- Use the **Comprehensive Plan** to provide recommendations to the community, developers, Commission, and Council, while pursuing goals of the plan according to the implementation schedule
- Use the **Transportation Master Plan** to carry out transportation initiatives as set forth in the plan

3 Planning & Zoning Commission

- Use the **Comprehensive Plan** to make recommendations to the City Council regarding planning and zoning cases
- Use the **Transportation Master Plan** to plan for upcoming transportation infrastructure upgrades and new projects as recommended by the plan

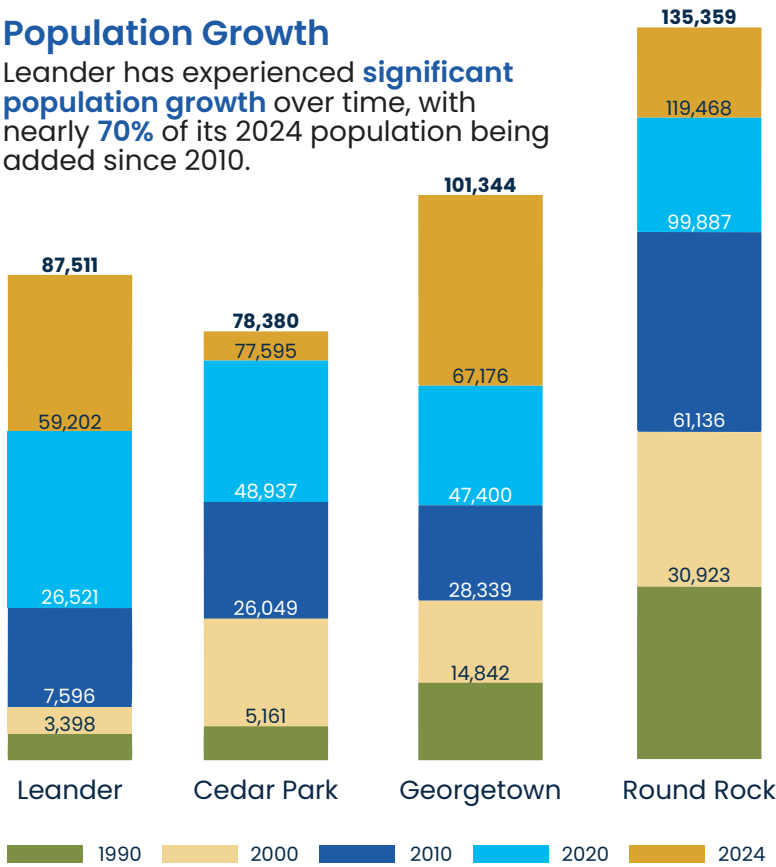


Leander Today

Leander has experienced **significant population growth** over time, with nearly **70%** of its 2024 population being added since 2010.

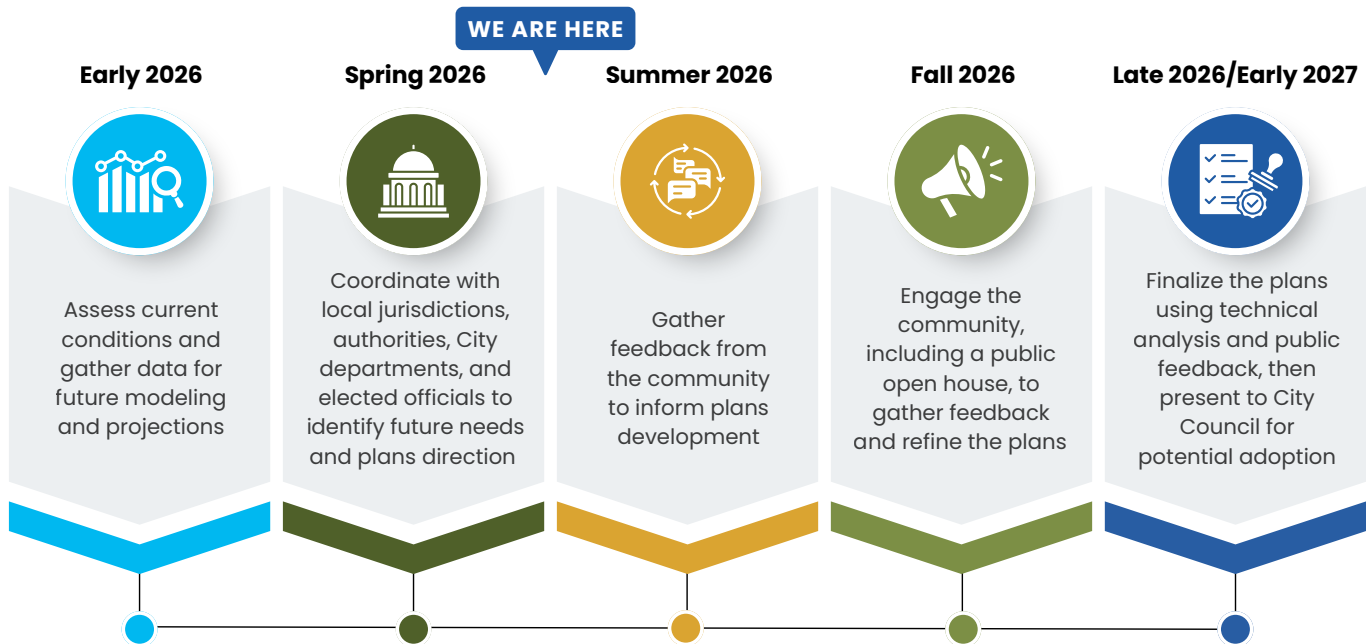


Community Profile
